Our fiscal year end of June 30, 2022 saw us move into the 3rd year of dealing with the impacts of the coronavirus pandemic. At Hegg Health Center and specifically at Whispering Heights long-term care center, the largest on-going challenges relate to a lack of available staffing and the financial challenges that have come with record inflation growth in both wages and supplies.

Hegg is not alone in facing staffing shortage challenges. Healthcare centers across the country are finding it difficult to find individuals to fill open positions, especially in the area of Certified Nurse Aides. Whispering Heights currently has around 10 open beds due to this issue, which creates a challenge for both the facility and the community. National statistics show that 75 percent of healthcare workers report experiencing stress, anxiety and burnout compared to pre-pandemic measures, which leads to increased turnover rates, increasing the challenges.

Inflationary pressures across the health system have driven supply and wages expenses up over 30% since before the pandemic. Most businesses are able to pass the majority of that increase along to the end customer, but that isn't the case in healthcare where insurance companies have provided a meager annual increase of about 2.3%. There is no place to pass on the additional expense and accordingly the health center experienced operational losses in FY 2022 Foundation returns were also under pressure during the year resulting in an overall negative margin.

Despite the challenges, I am confident that we will weather the storm as we have a number of times over the years. We continue to looks for ways to operate as efficiently as possible, while at the same time understanding that we need to continue to grow and provide the high-quality services the community has come to expect.

We are very pleased that Dr. David Adams is off and running in his practice since joining us earlier this fall, and we continue to recruit additional providers in order to create more capacity in the clinic.

Thank you for your support over the past year and all of us at Hegg look forward to serving our community in the year ahead!




